

HEALTHCARE PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY

The content of these provisions, issued according to the guidelines of the Ministry of Health and the Technical Scientific Committee (TSC) of Civil Protection, is based on the current epidemiological situation and on the scientific knowledge available to date, therefore it can be updated following the evolving situation.

In order to protect the health of both the attending staff and the teaching staff, as well as of all the staff of the MNCG, and to minimize the infectious disease risk from SARS-CoV-2, which in any case cannot be eliminated entirely, it is deemed necessary to implement the following procedures:

- **BEFORE THE INFLUX:** before embarking on the journey, all students must check their body temperature and, in the event of a fever (body temperature > 37.5 ° C) and/or other symptoms (e.g. cough, sore throat, rhinorrhea, loss of smell or taste, breathing difficulties, general malaise, flu-like symptoms, pneumonia, etc.), are required to remain at home, giving timely communication to the MNCG. In order to ensure prompt, punctual and adherent tracking activities of the subjects, in case they turned out to be positive and identify any "close contacts", it is recommended that all staff use the official "IMMUNI" app on their mobile phone, available on the App Store, Play Store and App Gallery, downloadable from the website <https://www.immuni.it/it/download.html>;
- **DURING THE INFLUX:** when entering the M. Fiore barracks in Motta di Livenza (TV), all staff, equipped with surgical masks, are subjected to daily body temperature measurements: in the event of body temperature check > 37.5 ° C, the interested party cannot access the M. Fiore Barracks and must follow the instructions in the following paragraph. Once entering the barracks, the attending staff must complete and sign the self-certification in **Annex 1** (as per letter prot. 01/160 on 16/june/2020 of SMD-IGESAN), with which they certify the following conditions:
 - a. not accusing, nor having accused in the 14 days prior to the presentation, symptoms related to the SARS-CoV-2 infection;
 - b. not having had close contacts with SARS-CoV-2 positive subjects in the previous 14 days;
 - c. not being, at present, subject to restrictive provisions of quarantine and/or home trustee isolation;
 - d. not, at present, be waiting for the outcome of a oro-nasopharyngeal swab for SARS-CoV-2 detection.

The self-certification in **Annex 1** must be filled out again and signed upon return to the M. Fiore Barracks in the event of a prolonged absence of more than 24 hours (e.g. after the weekend);

- **DURING THE COURSE:** all staff must avoid gatherings and direct physical contacts (e.g. handshakes, hugs, etc.), maintaining an interpersonal distance > 1 meter and abiding to the rules of good hygiene and health practice; in case of permanence in closed places, besides this it is mandatory to wear a surgical mask. Each student, equipped with a special dispenser containing disinfectant solution for surfaces, must daily sanitize his/her workstation (desk, chair, PC, etc.). In addition, each student must use only their own stationery (pens, pencils, erasers, etc.), as well as their notebooks, books, notes. During classroom lessons, adequate air exchange must be guaranteed and therefore, by the teaching staff, the periodic natural ventilation of the classrooms must be assured by opening the windows for 15 minutes every 45 minutes of lessons.

BODY TEMPERATURE CHECK > 37.5 ° C AND/OR SUSPECTED SYMPTOMS ONSET FOR COVID-19.

In case of body temperature check > 37.5 ° C and/or onset of suspected symptoms for COVID-19 (e.g. cough, sore throat, rhinorrhea, loss of smell or taste, difficulty breathing, general indisposition, flu-like symptoms, pneumonia, etc.), the interested party cannot access the M. Fiore barracks and must immediately return to his/her accommodation/room (always wearing a surgical mask) and place themselves in **self-isolation**¹, implementing the following procedures:

- contact the SISP (Hygiene and Public Health Service) of *ULSS 2 "Marca Trevigiana"* by phone at the following number **0422-323888** (Call Center *Nuovo Coronavirus*, active from Monday to Saturday from 08:00 to 16:00) and communicate your health conditions; alternatively, contact the toll-free number **800 462 340**, specially activated by the Veneto Region, and follow the operator's instructions;
- send an email to the SISP of *ULSS 2 "Marca Trevigiana"* to the following address <mailto:coronavirus.sisp@aulss2.veneto.it> communicating your personal data: name, surname, date of birth, telephone number, country of origin, place (airport, station, port, etc.) and date of entry into Italy, address where the possible quarantine for 14 days will take place.

The ULSS 2 SISP will evaluate whether or not to test the interested party with an **oro-nasopharyngeal swab for the detection for SARS-CoV-2**² and, if the latter has a **POSITIVE** result:

- the interested party will be placed in mandatory home isolation with active surveillance until a double negative swab for SARS-CoV-2 is found;
- all the attending or teaching staff who came into close and/or casual contact with the interested party may, following the relevant Health Authority's directions, be placed in precautionary quarantine at their home for 14 days from the date of the last exposure with the suspected case and possibly be tested with an **oro-nasopharyngeal swab**.

If, on the other hand, the oro-nasopharyngeal swab has a **NEGATIVE** result, the interested party may be placed, following the relevant Health Authority's directions, in precautionary quarantine at his/her home for 14 days.

If the interested party has previously downloaded the *"IMMUNI"* App, he/she must send the data to the Ministry of Health through the application itself, which will generate a numeric code (OTP) that the user must communicate to the healthcare professional of the ULSS SISP 2. By doing so, the App will notify other users about the risk they have been exposed to and the indications to follow.

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- 1 That is, stay in a specific room with a closed door or in an area away from other staff or pets, ensuring adequate natural ventilation and using a separate bathroom, if available.
 - 2 **The oro-nasopharyngeal swab for SARS-CoV-2** is carried out at the *"La Madonnina"* building, located in via Castellana, n. 2, 31100 - Treviso (TV), with the "drive through" access, that is, accessing with a private vehicle and remaining inside the passenger compartment. In the event that the interested party does not have his/her own vehicle available, he/she can contact an External Agency/Organization/Association of the Defense Administration (such as, for example, the Italian Red Cross – Oderzo Committee at 0422-815657 or 347-3337333; or "Castel Monte Onlus" located in Casale sul Sile (TV) - Taxiambulance at nr. 0422-303409) and organize transport with a dedicated vehicle, with any charges to be borne by the interested party.
