06-17 SEP	INTERCULTURAL MEDIATOR IN CIMIC CONTEXT COURSE (IMC 01/21)	<p>Course is aimed to fully engage students into the complexity of the current and more relevant geo-strategic scenarios and provide basic knowledge and competences to fulfil their role of main facilitator for the establishment of an effective liaison between military actors and the ample complex and intercultural domain of non-military actors.</p> <p>The secondary purpose is to enhance CIMIC personnel skills &amp; capabilities to face the new challenges of modern Theatres of Operations from hybrid threats to mass migrations, from Climate change to Trans-national criminal activities.</p>	<p>Nominees should be military (OR5 and above) or equivalent civilian personnel who are or will be appointed to a CIMIC assignment from tactical to strategic level. The course is also open to civilians with a vested interest in civil military interaction and intercultural communication;</p>
04-08 OCT	CIMIC LIAISON COURSE (CLC 01/21)	<p>Follow up of NCFWC/ NCSWC. Main purpose of the CLC is to cover communication and negotiation skills that will strengthen student's abilities to meet the challenges of a CIMIC liaison officer.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">As per NCFWC/ NCSWC Prerequisite for attendance is: successful participation in a previous CIMIC course</p>
