



On 13th February 2008, Warrant Officer Giovanni Pezzulo, from the CIMIC Group South and part of Task Force Surobi, was killed in a firefight claimed by the Taliban, about 60 kilometers from Kabul, in the town of Rudbar, during a civil-military cooperation activity.

The flags' square has been named in his honor. Every year Multinational CIMIC Group staff recalls his memory with a small ceremony held at the cemetery of Oderzo (Treviso) attended, also, by the family, on the 2nd November (recurrence of deaths) and every 13th of February.

"It is said that no one dies on earth as long as he lives in the heart of those who remain and Giovanni is still here with us. Every year we respect his memory by commemorating him as today. Second Lieutenant Pezzulo has done and continues to do something great. It gives us the opportunity to come together and reflect on the volatility of life and the essence of being military. There is no doubt that this will always be his second home." (MNCG Operator)

The taliban exploded a car outside the gate of a NATO base in the western Afghan city of Herat, setting off a gun battle as a bomber blew up amid a downtown crowd. The car bomb targeted the Provincial Reconstruction Team office, which coordinates the coalition's support for development and governance in the province. The Italian defense minister said five Italian soldiers were wounded. No one amongst Multinational CIMIC Group operators were effected seriously by the explosion.



The Coat of Arms

"Maximize resources and harmonize all stakeholders' effort: this is the goal"

The coat of arms of the Multinational CIMIC Group, from 2002 to 2009 CIMIC Group South, was born from the collaboration with CIMIC Group North, now transformed in CIMIC Centre of Excellence (CCOE). The coats of arms of the two units were originally similar in graphics and, in part, in the use of colors. Today at the top of the coat there is the inscription "Multinational CIMIC Group", below which appears a handshake, a gesture elected as a symbol of humanitarian aid and cooperation. The green color expresses the hope that regiment must bring to civilian populations in crisis areas. The white and blue represent the colors of the robe (sari) of Mother Teresa of Calcutta, the patron saint of the unit. The motto of MNCG is "Militescivisquealacriter" and refers to the goal of the Multinational CIMIC Group, which is to reduce the distance between the military and the civil sphere in a synergistic, rapid and voluntary way.
